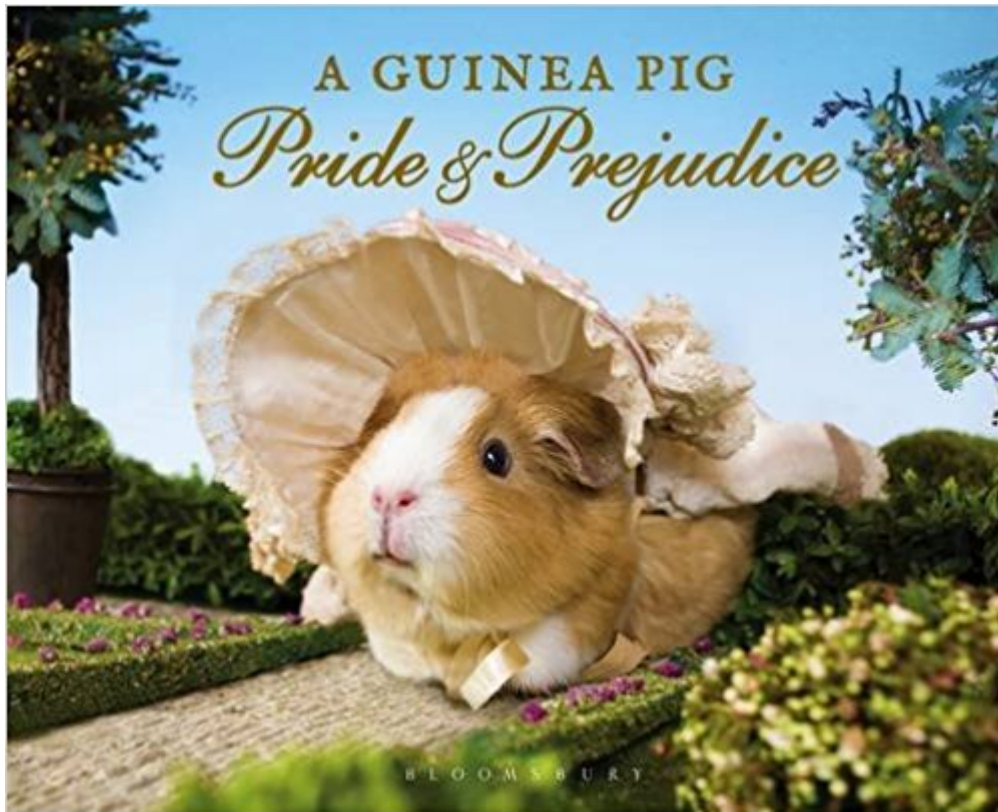

There were a few snippets that didnâ™t exactly follow the story but you can forgive the slight, considering the length of the book. Plus, for the people who have never read P&P, the story might make a little more understandable without going into deep details. The book itself is really well constructed. The photos are clear and sharp. The casting choice, I do have to say, was spot on. Readable. This is not meant for young children to read alone. There are words that might go over their heads.If you are a P&P fan or know someone who is, this is a perfect gift. It is a little pricey but it is so cute. I have no regrets.

I cannot even with how much I love this. I actually bought it as a gift for my mother, but couldn't resist (carefully) reading it myself the day that it came in. Bear in mind that this is a cute product for Jane Austen lovers- it is NOT the complete book. It follows the main events in a page or two each, and each page is more or less a paragraph, with a quote beneath each guinea pig pic.

This is an absolutely charming little book that with delight any guinea pig fancier or Jane Austin fan. The pictures are richly colored and detailed.
